#### Protective Measures Overview



- All certificated staff complete the Covid-19 Protocols PD Modules through Rise
- Cohorting of students: MS: 3 per A/B, HS: 2 per A/B for 9th and 10th grade
- Temp Screening Check-point daily of students (MPR for MS, Yard Gate for HS)
- Mask Policy (minimum requirements: staff: 3-ply, students: cloth or other)
- Student/Teacher **Shields**: Desktop at all times, teacher stations as often as able
- Surface Decontaminating: HS Classrooms between periods(students), lunch area
- Physical Distancing: Maintain 6ft ring outside and inside buildings
- Handwashing and Sanitizer: All sinks(soap) and Sani: lunch areas, outside offices
- Directional Markers and Signage: for traffic flow and distancing
- Campus Flow: HS, counterclockwise, MS wings one way flow in and out of rooms
- **Symptomatic** Students: Isolation Area-w/ Health Sub (MPR)
- Staggered release of students at end of instruction daily




### Student Arrival

- Check-In: HS Station Opens at 9:05am, MS Station at 9:10am Teaching staff to be ready at those times to receive students - doors open
- 2. Students exit check-in, then report directly to 1st/2nd Period Classroom Assignment
- MS: Students take assigned seat (Grade 5-8) use name stickers on desks
   HS: Students wipe down desk, but create seating chart
- 4. Instruction Begins: HS 9:25am, MS 9:40am
- 5. Tardies: No marking "tardy" students just as with distance instruction

### Student Arrival






#### In and Around the Classroom

- Limit <u>student movement</u> to individuals (restroom, sink, trash, dismissal system)
- <u>Collaboration</u> digitally, whole group, but no regrouping of chairs/desks
- Restroom as needed, no pass, one at a time, do not wait for class breaks
- Mask Compliance gentle reminders if becoming defiance summon campus supervisor
- Ill or <u>symptomatic student</u>? Call Health Office before sending to isolation area
- <u>Sharing</u> Materials? Avoid, must clean between any changing of hands within or between cohorts
- Tech Issues: Have back-up plan/manipulatives (paper ok)
- HS Passing (Student Pre and Post wipe down protocol)
- MS Passing Teacher rotations, students remain, stretch in place, class walks
- HS Open Period Students: Assigned to space within classrooms, within cohort
- MS PE Release: Drop-off and Pick-up at stairway, one class at a time, use system for order of release. See PE Release Map







#### See Lunch Maps Grab and Go only.

- MS Release in room order system following flow of map. Return in reverse order - teacher pick-up/signal - Teams work out return system
- HS Release 9/10 to Midfield, 11/12 to Yard following flow Return bell signal to release back to class, open doors monitor milling (should be none)
- Seating in lunch areas by cohort, bench stickers for separation
- Inclement weather classrooms, brown bag delivery for school lunch, supervision by classified staff, teacher voluntary
