## Scheduling - Message to Families:

During this first phase of In-Person-Distance Learning in RUSD, the academic day at all secondary schools, including RSA, has been broken into three blocks of instructional time, with the exception of Wednesday. During each block each day, teachers will be interacting live with students for a portion of the block. The District will be using a 6-period system that is dividied into these three daily blocks where periods will alternate each day (evens-odds). Under normal circumstances, the RSA middle school program operated on a 5-period schedule divided into similar blocks - 3 core academic courses (Math, Science, and Humanities-which is ELA and History) plus PE. For this Academic Year, most RSA students will see 6 periods on their class schedules (Math, Science, Language Arts, PE, Enrichment and STEMWorks) and a seventh class (History). At STEM, History content has always been embedded within the language arts course and will continue to be this year (we refer to this course as Humanities). Although the additional class period appears on student schedules, it will not meet as a separate class period or occupy a separate class meeting time, instead it will be part of the Language Arts class time. Additionally, the Enrichment and STEMworks class periods that appear on student schedules will be used for additional instruction and enrichment of course content covered in each of the student's academic courses, and each grade level team will explain to students and families how that instructional time will be utilized during this first phase of the In-Person-distance learning program.
